

CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION

The Kansas Medical Society is recognized by the ACCME (Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education) to accredit CME programs. The KMS currently accredits 12 institutions/organizations throughout the state of Kansas. Recognition as an accredited institution enables medical staff the opportunity to receive quality educational programs designed to meet nationally accepted standards. In addition, accredited institutions help physicians fulfill their continuing medical education requirements for medical re-licensure.

The purpose of this program is to survey and accredit local organizations to ensure that they are in substantial compliance with the KMS Essential Areas and Elements for Accreditation of Continuing Medical Education. It is the responsibility of the KMS to ensure that those accredited institutions follow rules and regulations that meet minimum requirements established by the ACCME.

The organizations accredited by the KMS Continuing Medical Education Committee are listed below. The committee surveys organizations to determine whether their accreditation status should be continued. The surveys consist of a site visit by a survey team of two committee members. Interviews are conducted with key people and records and minutes are reviewed to determine if the program is in compliance with the accreditation requirements.
